# REX ALLEN DAYS 2017 PARADE INSTRUCTIONS

**DATE OF PARADE:** Saturday, October 7th, 2017  
**Line up 7:30am-9:30am. Day-of entries will be taken until 9:00am**  
Parade starts at 10:00 A.M.

**PARADE THEME:** **Renegades, Wranglers and Rogues**

**PARADE ROUTE:** Staging for the parade will begin at 8 am on Austin Boulevard at the west end of the Community Center located at Austin Boulevard and Stewart Street. (You will note the star on the map which is on PAGE 3.) Easiest access will be coming from Arizona Avenue and turning east on Maley and go to Austin and turn north and you will see the staging on the right side in the alongside the park behind the community center, just north of Maley Street.

VEHICLES NOT PART OF THE PARADE can be parked on the south side Maley on Biddle (where there is an empty lot) or along Grant Street or along Curtis Street, in which there some empty parking lots and dirt lots. WE DO REQUIRE THAT YOU MAKE SURE NOT TO BLOCK ANY PRIVATE RESIDENCE OR BUSINESS ACCESS as this could cause loss of opportunity to park in these locations at future events or cause the requirement of a fee, which is not asked for at this time.

We ask that you check in by 9:30 am at the Staging desk located at the Parade Staging Desk located behind the Community Center on Austin Boulevard. You will receive a staging number that will need to be easily seen on front passenger side of vehicles or on left side that announcers and judges can see the number from a distance of one block away. We will try to assist you devices to attach number, but providing your own form of attachment will probably be more secure than what we provide.

You will be given directions and map as to where you are to park for staging and there will be assistance available. We ask for your patience and safe practices in getting to your parking place for parade staging as there will be many other participants trying to get to their location and parking. We ask that once you find your location and park to make every effort of staying in your location and keeping participants of your parade entry at the location for theirs and others safety and for an on time start of the parade.

**SIGNS & VEHICLES:** Generic entry signs will be provided to entrants, ALL entries may supply their own signs and any mounts or vehicles are the entrant's responsibility. No more than 5 vehicles per entry unless otherwise arranged with Parade Committee and authorized by RAD, Inc.

**TROPHIES:** Trophies will be awarded at the Keiller Park located on Bisbee Avenue at 3:00pm. Unclaimed trophies will be awarded at following RAD board meetings, notices to winners of meetings will be sent.

Be aware it will be **HOT** and there is **NO** water available in the staging area. Bring water for yourselves and others in your group.

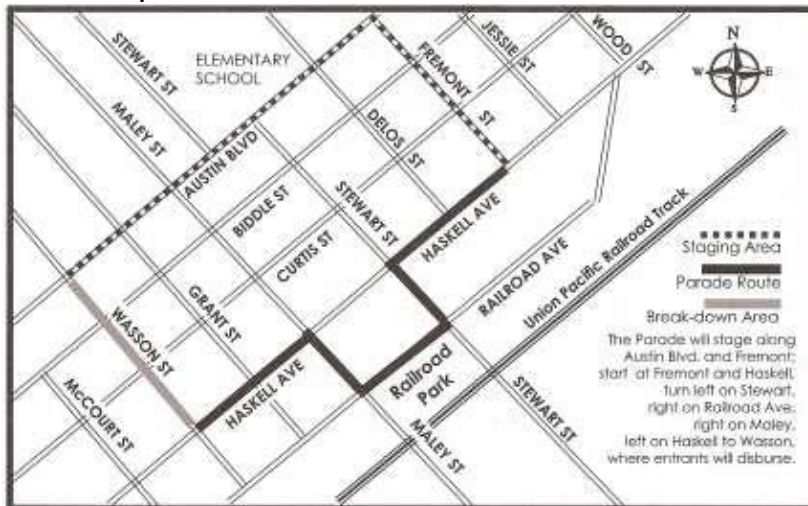
Applications **MUST** be filled out and at the registration stand before entries are allowed to stage. Right to refusal of staging is reserved by the Rex Allen Days, Inc.

**When filling out the application**, please do not use the back of pages 2 and 3 of the application for additional comments. Only use the back of page 1 if additional announcer comment space needed. Note the 75 word limit to prevent delays.

For 2017 judging for groups and musical entries will be done by guest judges along the parade route. Groups will be judge on costumes, crowd interaction and character portrayals. Judges will be randomly seated along the parade route, so it is in your best interest to do your best throughout the route and enjoy the parade. President's trophy, float and Horse Drawn will be selected before the parade begins, in the line-up area, between 9am-9:30am.
